My name is Bobby Nash, your neighbor at 310 Nottingham Oaks Trail. I am one of the local Boy Scouts in BSA Troop 1089 who puts out the flags you may have seen around the neighborhood on several holidays during the year. I am writing to see if you would like to participate in the program.

Enclosing a detailed brochure on the program; if you would like to start your annual subscription this coming Veterans Day please let me know before the end of October so we have time to install your flag holder. For your convenience feel free to mail the brochure back to me with your check for \$30.00 for a one year subscription made out to “BSA Troop 1089,” or call me anytime and I will be happy to come down and pick everything up in person.

Regarding installation; an adult scout member will install a small piece of PVC pipe near the curb into which the flag is placed on flag days. If there are any concerns about sprinkler systems we will consult with you to locate a safe place for the installation. When not in use the pipe has a small cover on it to protect it and keep it hidden. There is no danger from lawn mowers as the pipe is at or below ground level. The scouts store the flags at their homes, and they put them out and pick them up on flags days, there is really nothing you need do but enjoy your flag!
