PACKRAFTING IN MONTANA



July 16 - 23 2017

Where: Montana High Adventure Base (MOHAB), Great Falls Montana

Estimated Costs: \$782 per participant *excluding* return air transport, from Houston We will fly from Houston to Great Falls International (GTF) - flight costs and total trip price, including insurance will be communicated later.

Deposit \$250 each for Scout and Adults due **September 14th 2017**. Remainder due in installments by March 31st 2017.

Trip Overview: 10 times as much room to roam as Philmont - The nation's premiere wilderness expedition training and instruction program serving the High Adventure needs of Boy Scouts and Venturers worldwide. We have 26 places on this adventure, comprised of scouts and adults divided into 2 groups of 13. Places will be allocated in order of signup with a wait list in operation once 26 have signed up.

Scout and Adult Eligibility requirements:

See Mohab website for an idea of the preparation that is needed for you to fully enjoy MOHAB High Adventure

- a. All participants must be currently registered with the Troop and BSA.
- b. All participants must pass a BSA swim test in a strong manner prior to arriving at MOHAB
- c. Philmont height/weight restrictions apply. Trek crews must participate in a “shakedown hike” on arrival at MOHAB to evaluate whether you are physically fit for backcountry travel.
- d. All participants must have a current BSA Health and Medical Record (Parts A, B, C), signed by a doctor that is no more than a year old.
- e. The minimum age to attend Troop 1089 High Adventure **14 years old**, talk to Scout leadership for more information
